

Facts

- 3 505 beneficiaries from "Priority neighbourhoods" during school year 2021-22
- In schools, each beneficiary gets at least 16 hours of Physical Education in English
- In clubs, our European volunteers co-animate sessions at least twice a week during 28 weeks
- The volunteers participate to our partners' holiday camps



As of November 2022, 10 European volunteers are conducting their missions of teaching English in schools and Tennis & Muay Thai clubs in Paris Region and the South Region. A project funded by Impact 2024, in a consortium with Fête le Mur and the Académie française de Muay Thaï
